### Notice of Race

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority is the Mount Sinai Sailing Association.
- 1.2 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.3 RRS 52 is changed to allow autopilots on boats that are sailed double-handed or single-handed.
- 1.4 Racing Classes are limited to Single Hulled Sailboats using Jib and Main Only.

#### 2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The Race Series is open to all competitors regardless of sailing/yacht club affiliation.
- 2.2 Eligibility for the MSSA Pro/Am Trophy is restricted to vessels that have not previously competed in a MSSA High Point Race Series.

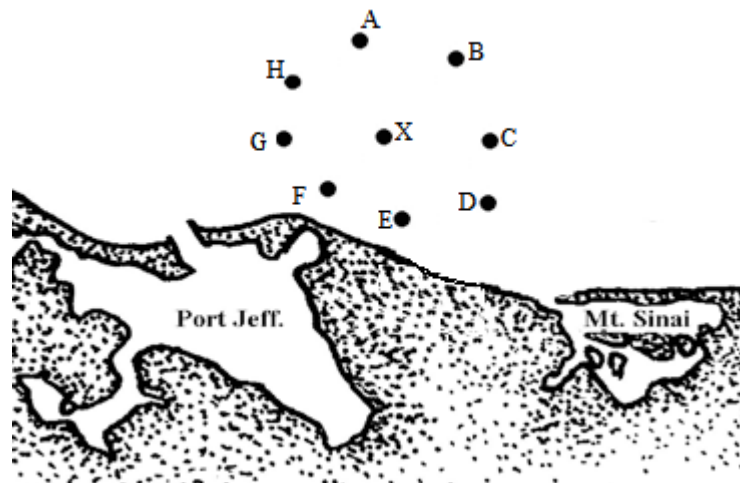
